As the director of the Freed-Hardeman University soccer camp, I am looking forward to sharing part of the summer with your child as a student in our 2011 camp.

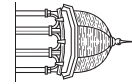
We will utilize current FHU players as counselors so that each camper receives quality observation, coaching, and supervision. Our week is action-packed and your children will leave campus with some of the best training they could receive – and also very tired. Our day begins with breakfast and closes around 9:30 p.m. with our evening lecture. One new feature this year is the team aspect of camp where teams can come together as a group and will play in the evening scrimmages as a team in 11 v 11 matches. We encourage teams to sign up early as spots will go quickly. ## THE DIRECTOR

Jason Elliott is the director of all Freed-Hardeman University soccer camps. He has led the Lion and Lady Lion soccer programs since the fall of 2001 and his camps have been the fastest growing camps in the area. Coach Elliott directed the men's and

women's soccer teams to historic season in 2010. The men finished 13-5 on the season and third place in the TranSouth Conference while the women finished 10-6-3. Coach Elliott was selected as TranSouth Conference Men's Soccer Coach of the Year in 2010. He will also utilize current and former FHU players from many states including Tennessee, Kentucky, Alabama, Louisiana, Missouri, Texas, Illinois, Ohio, and Mississippi as well as several foreign countries. The camp is known for placing campers into a challenging environment while letting the game be the greatest teacher.

## BOYS & GIRLS BOARDING CAMP

June 19-23, Ages 10-18

### REGISTRATION

Campers check in on June 19 between 4 and 6 p.m. at the FHU Sports Center. Check-out will follow the awards ceremony at 11:30 a.m. on the last day of camp at the soccer field. Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis until the camp is full. Camp will close after 175 spots have been taken and a waiting list will be formed at that time. Early registration is strongly encouraged and a \$25 late registration fee will be charged for registration postmarked after June 12th. You may also register on our website for faster confirmation. Upon receiving your camp application, we will mail you a confirmation of your spot in camp, a detailed list of what to bring, and the amount due at registration.

### COST

Tuition for the camp is \$225 per individual (boarding rate). This covers all meals, housing, facility use, instruction and insurance. For those who do



not stay in university dormitories, the cost is \$200 (commuter rate). Commuters will need to arrive by 9 a.m. each morning, and be picked up at 9:30 p.m. each night at the field. The team rate with twelve or more athletes attending the camp is \$195 per player. The family rate with 2 or more athletes attending from the same household is also \$195 per player.

### CAMPERS RECEIVE

Each camper will receive an official Diadora camp ball, camp notebook, t-shirt, individual written evaluation and insurance coverage.

### WHAT TO BRING

Campers should come with plenty of practice attire, a good pair of cleats, bed linens and toiletries. Campers should also bring spending money for the concessions stand. A camp bank will be available at registration so campers will not have to carry money throughout the week and at the end of the week whatever is left will be reimbursed. The concessions stand will have sport drinks and snacks and each night pizza and sandwiches can be purchased from concessions.

### DESCRIPTION OF CAMP

Campers will learn the fundamentals of the game. Each camper will be challenged by the staff, the curriculum, fellow campers and by the game of soccer itself. Campers are divided by age groups and ability. To enhance the development of each player, the FHU soccer camp combines a strong emphasis on individual skill, along with advanced team tactics. Each morning, training will involve techniques of finishing, passing, dribbling and general ball control. The afternoon will focus on tactical development and field awareness, while the evenings are reserved for scrimmages in full 11 v 11 format.

### FACILITIES

The Freed-Hardeman soccer camp is located on campus in Henderson, Tenn. Two first-class Bermuda grass soccer fields, complete with sprinkler systems and world-cup goals will be utilized for all activities. The collegiate game field, which will be used for many of the scrimmages, is equipped with a state-of-the-art lighting system that is one

of the best in the area. A concessions stand and restroom facilities are located within feet of the pitch. The Josh Riley Soccer Complex is a first-class facility that every camper will enjoy training on. Campers will stay in air-conditioned dorms and receive three all-you-can-eat daily meals in Wallace Gano Dining Hall. FHU also offers a full sports medicine facility so each camper is guaranteed the best treatment.

### TEAM CAMP

Our team camp is a popular aspect of camp. We will still have our normal individual camp and individual campers will form teams for our evening scrimmages, but if your team is able to come, you will be housed together and scrimmage together in the evenings. Your coach is also welcome to come and stay with you and coach you during these scrimmages. If your coach is unable to come, you will be assigned a coach from our staff. T-shirts will be color-coordinated according to teams for the evening matches. Teams will be split up for normal activities during the day. You must have a minimum of 12 players to qualify as a team. The coach or sponsor should contact us early to make sure your team's spot is reserved.

**DESCRIPTION:** This is an abbreviated version of camp designed to get children interested in the world's most popular sport. We will focus on basic soccer skills and knowledge of the game while emphasizing fun and getting involved. Our university players will assist so that each child has someone close by. Each camper will receive a camp ball and t-shirt.
